SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 20, 2014

SB 1060 Senator Middleton

HOMEOWNER'S INSURANCE – REQUIRED NOTICES

Requiring an insurer that issues, sells, or delivers a homeowner's insurance policy, at the time of application and at each renewal, to provide an applicant or a policyholder with a specified written notice; specifying the information that must be included in the notice; requiring the notice to be clear and specific; providing that the notice is not part of the policy or contract of insurance; etc.

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SB 1061 Senator Pugh**TRUANT STUDENTS – SYSTEM OF ACTIVE INTERVENTION – REQUIREMENTS**

Requiring the system of active intervention for specified truant students developed by each county board of education to include an Individualized Reengagement Plan for each truant student, coordination and collaboration with State and municipal agencies to deliver services, creation of a database to track truant students, and a specific plan for each public school to reengage truant students; requiring the Individualized Reengagement Plan to be developed by specified individuals using a specified process; etc.

SB 1062 Senator Kelley**EDUCATION – BALTIMORE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD NOMINATING COMMISSION**

Establishing the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission; providing for the membership, duties, terms, and staffing of the Commission; requiring the Governor to designate the Commission chair; requiring the Governor to make appointments to the Baltimore County Board of Education from a list of nominees submitted by the Commission; providing that a member's appointment to the county board is subject to approval or rejection by the registered voters of the county at a specified election; etc.

SB 1063 Senator Colburn**BUSINESS REGULATION – PAWNBROKERS – REQUIRED RECORDS FOR CURRENCY**

Authorizing counties and municipalities to regulate specified activities involving coins; requiring pawnbrokers to make a certain written record on a business transaction that involves currency, including coins; and making specified provisions of law relating to holding and tagging of items purchased in a pawn transaction applicable to currency, including coins.

SB 1064 Senator Jones–Rodwell**MARYLAND CONSOLIDATED CAPITAL BOND LOAN OF 2012 – BALTIMORE CITY – PMO COMMUNITY YOUTH CENTER**

Amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2012 to authorize the required matching fund for a grant for the PMO Community Youth Center to include real property; extending the deadline to June 1, 2016, for the Board of Directors of Payne Memorial Outreach, Inc. to present evidence of a certain matching fund; etc.

SB 1065 Senator Conway**TASK FORCE ON COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS**

Establishing the Task Force on Community Health Workers; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; requiring the Task Force to conduct a specified study, develop specified training and practice standards, and develop specified recommendations; requiring the Task Force to submit specified reports to specified committees of the General Assembly on or before specified dates; etc.
