## SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 28, 2014

### **SB 1089** Senator Astle

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY – SOUTHERN MIDDLE SCHOOL AND SOUTHERN HIGH SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County for specified development or improvement purposes related to the Southern Middle School and Southern High School, including installing emergency generators, located in Anne Arundel County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

### **SB 1090** Prince George's County Senators

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY – CIRCUIT COURT – ATTORNEY APPEARANCE FEE

Increasing the attorney appearance fees payable to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County; and altering the purposes for which the appearance fees collected by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County may be used to include the general purposes of the jury office.

**SB 1091 Senator Klausmeier****FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS – TRANSITIONAL MORTGAGE LOAN ORIGINATOR LICENSES**

Authorizing the Commissioner of Financial Regulation to issue a transitional mortgage loan originator license to specified individuals under specified circumstances; requiring an applicant for a license to submit a specified application to the Commissioner and comply with specified conditions and provisions of the application; requiring an applicant for a license to pay a specified fee; specifying the content of a specified application; etc.

**SB 1092 Senator Jennings****HEALTH GENERAL – MILK PRODUCTS – DIRECT-TO-CONSUMER SALE OF RAW MILK**

Excluding specified sales of raw milk from specified State regulation of milk products; creating an exception to the prohibition against the sale of raw milk; authorizing the sale of raw milk directly to the consumer in accordance with specified requirements; restricting the authorization to sell raw milk directly to the consumer to specified persons; requiring testing of specified animals; prohibiting the sale of raw milk unless a specified contract is executed; requiring specified testing of specified animals; etc.
