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## **SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED *March 7, 2014***

### **SB 1104 Senators Middleton and Ramirez**

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND MEDICAL SYSTEM CORPORATION –  
GOVERNANCE – MEDICAL CENTER EMPLOYEES

Requiring the Board of Directors of the University of Maryland Medical System Corporation to establish a nonprofit subsidiary to operate all or a part of the University of Maryland Medical Center in order to bring specified Medical Center employees within the jurisdiction of the National Labor Relations Act; authorizing the Medical System Corporation, on or after October 1, 2014, to amend its articles of incorporation to add up to three specified voting members to the Board of Directors; etc.

**SB 1105** Senators Manno and RobeyTEMPORARY CASH ASSISTANCE – TERMINATION OF BENEFITS  
AND CASE CLOSURE – TIMING

Authorizing the Secretary of Human Resources, during a specified period of time, to suspend payment of temporary cash assistance to a recipient who is found to be in noncompliance with specified income eligibility standards due to an increase in a child support payment; prohibiting the Secretary from terminating the temporary cash assistance or closing the case of the recipient during the 3 months after the end of the month in which the increased support payment is received; etc.

**SB 1106** Senator FeldmanBUSINESS OCCUPATIONS – REAL ESTATE APPRAISERS –  
CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECKS

Requiring applicants for a license or certificate to provide real estate appraisal services to apply for a national and State criminal history records check, submit a complete set of fingerprints, and pay the fees for the records checks; requiring the Criminal Justice Information System of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to provide the records and a specified receipt of the application to the State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers, Appraisal Management Companies, and Home Inspectors; etc.

RESIDENTIAL CHILD CARE PROGRAMS – STATEMENT OF NEED –  
EXCEPTION FOR TEMPORARY RELOCATION

Creating an exception to a specified statement of need requirement for the temporary relocation of an existing licensed residential child care program if the temporary site is located within the same jurisdiction as the site undergoing rehabilitation or within 10 miles of the original site and the rehabilitation of the existing site will be completed within 180 days or, if not, will be completed within a specified time period under specified circumstances; etc.
