### SB 232 Senator Cassilly

DEATH OR LIFE-THREATENING INJURY BY MOTOR VEHICLE OR VESSEL – SUBSEQUENT OFFENDERS – PENALTIES

Establishing subsequent offender penalties of imprisonment not to exceed 15 years or a fine not to exceed \$10,000 or both for specified offenses that result in the death or life—threatening injury to another as the result of a specified person driving, operating, or controlling a vehicle or vessel; and providing that specified offenses committed in another state or federal jurisdiction are to be considered for the application of specified subsequent offender penalties.

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Community Action Council of Howard County, Maryland, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Community Action Council Food Bank Facility, located in Howard County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$35,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Howard County Historical Society, Incorporated for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Howard County Historical Society facility, including repair of the roof, located in Howard County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

Requiring the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland to study the creation of a potential Pay It Forward Pilot Program; requiring the study to consider specified items; requiring the Board of Regents to study whether public institutions of higher education could successfully implement specified tuition freeze programs; providing for the termination of the Act; and requiring the Board of Regents to report its findings and recommendations on the potential programs on or before December 31, 2015.

Requiring insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations that provide specified health insurance benefits under specified insurance policies or contracts to provide coverage for specified equipment and supplies used for the treatment of ostomies; requiring the Maryland Insurance Commissioner, in consultation with the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, to adopt by regulation and periodically update a list of specified ostomy equipment and supplies; etc.

Altering the definition of "service contract", for purposes of provisions of law governing procurement contracts for services, to include services provided within a State—owned facility; requiring that specified units submit a specified demonstration to exclusive representatives; requiring that specified units meet with exclusive representatives to discuss alternatives to service contracts; requiring that service contracts be subject to an audit to determine compliance with specified requirements; etc.

Requiring the Professional Standards and Teacher Education Board to require, beginning on or after July 1, 2016, applicants for certification as a school counselor to have successfully completed a specified course regarding the recognition of, initial screening for, and response to emotional and behavioral distress in students and other individuals; requiring a specified course to include specified information; requiring the Board to adopt specified regulations; etc.

Requiring the Department of Agriculture on or before July 1, 2016 to conduct a comprehensive assessment of the impacts of climate change on agriculture in the State; requiring the University of Maryland Center for Environmental Science to establish specified sea level rise projections; requiring the Secretary of Natural Resources to update Maryland Environmental Policy Act guidelines; altering the State's Economic Growth, Resource Protection, and Planning Policy to include the consideration of climate change risks; etc.

Authorizing the State Department of Education, the State Board of Education, a county board of education, a local school system, a primary school, or a secondary school to collect or disclose the education records, or personally identifiable information contained in the education records, of a student only as necessary or required for specified purposes; prohibiting a person from requiring a specified student, without prior written consent, to submit to a survey, an analysis, or an evaluation that reveals specified information; etc.

Abolishing the Division of Pretrial Detention and Services within the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services; providing for the transfer of property, assets, licenses, credits, and rights of the Baltimore City Detention Center to the Mayor of Baltimore City; requiring the State to pay all the operating and capital costs of the Baltimore City Detention Center in fiscal years 2016 through 2018, one—half the costs in 2019, and providing that Baltimore City pay all the operating and capital costs in fiscal year 2020; etc.
