HOUSE BILLS INTRODUCED MARCH 7, 2016

HB 1625 Delegate Kramer

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – MONTGOMERY COUNTY – TORAH SCHOOL OF GREATER WASHINGTON

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$300,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Torah School of Greater Washington, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Torah School of Greater Washington, located in Montgomery County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

HB 1626 Delegates Long and Cluster

BALTIMORE COUNTY – PROPERTY TAX CREDIT – FALLEN OR DISABLED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND RESCUE WORKERS – ACQUISITION OF DWELLING

Altering the time period within which a disabled law enforcement officer or rescue worker or the surviving spouse of a fallen law enforcement officer or rescue worker shall have acquired specified residential property in Baltimore County in order to qualify for a specified property tax credit against the county or municipal corporation property tax imposed on the property; applying the Act to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 2016; etc.

VEHICLE LAWS – CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLES – PERMANENT REGISTRATION

Requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue a one-time, permanent registration for a Class G (trailer) vehicle when requested by the owner; establishing a fee schedule for the permanent registration of a Class G (trailer) vehicle according to the gross weight of the vehicle; establishing that a registration issued under the Act is not transferable; and establishing that a vehicle registered under the Act may not be used for hire except to haul farm products or in any manner other than as a farm trailer or semitrailer.

HB 1628 Delegate Barve**MARYLAND SMALL BUSINESS INNOVATION RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER INCENTIVE PROGRAM AND FUND**

Establishing the Maryland Small Business Innovation Research and Technology Transfer Incentive Program; establishing that the purpose of the Program is to foster job creation and economic development in the State in a specified manner; requiring the Maryland Technology Development Corporation to administer the Program; authorizing a specified small business to apply to the Corporation for a grant under the Program to reimburse specified costs and to match specified funding awards; etc.

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of A Wider Circle, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of A Wider Circle Community Service Center, located in Montgomery County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

Requiring the Dorchester County Superintendent of Schools to appoint specified clerical and nonprofessional personnel with the advice and consent of the Dorchester County Board of Education.

HB 1631 Delegate Rosenberg**ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT – PROPOSED REGULATION –
EXPLANATORY REASONS JUSTIFYING ADOPTION**

Requiring a promulgating unit to include, under specified circumstances, clearly written explanatory reasons with the submission of a proposed regulation to the Joint Committee on Administrative, Executive, and Legislative Review and the Department of Legislative Services.

HB 1632 Delegate M. Washington**BALTIMORE CITY SCHOOL POLICE OFFICERS – GUIDELINES AND
TRAINING – DISCIPLINE AND PUBLIC SAFETY**

Authorizing a Baltimore City school police officer to act in an official capacity in a school-based infraction only in a situation that poses an imminent threat of serious harm to another student or faculty member and in a manner that is fair, equitable, and consistent with due process; prohibiting a Baltimore City school police officer from engaging in specified discipline or acting in an official capacity in a school-based infraction that involves a specified student or constitutes a misdemeanor; etc.
