HB 1633 Delegate Glenn

UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE – MAXIMUM BENEFIT – INCREASE

Increasing the maximum weekly unemployment insurance benefit amount; providing for the application of the Act; and making specified provisions of the Act subject to a specified contingency.

JUVENILES – RESTRAINT AND SEARCHES – LIMITATIONS

Prohibiting the use of mechanical restraints by the Department of Juvenile Services on a child in the Department's custody except under specified circumstances; prohibiting the use of physical restraint by the Department on specified pregnant children and during labor, delivery, or postpartum recovery except under specified circumstances; authorizing a facility superintendent or the superintendent's superior to allow the search of a child under specified circumstances; etc.

HB 1635 Delegates Clippinger and Lierman**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – PORT DISCOVERY CHILDREN’S MUSEUM**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Baltimore Children’s Museum, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the Port Discovery Children’s Museum, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; etc.

HB 1636 Delegate Clippinger**BALTIMORE CITY – SOUTH BALTIMORE GATEWAY COMMUNITY BENEFITS DISTRICT AND DISTRIBUTION OF LOCAL IMPACT GRANTS**

Authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to establish specified community benefits district management authorities to include the South Baltimore Gateway Community Benefits District; requiring the ordinance establishing the South Baltimore Gateway Community Benefits District Management Authority to address specified matters; requiring, starting in a specified fiscal year, a specified percentage of local impact grants from video lottery proceeds to be distributed to the Authority; etc.
