HOUSE BILLS INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 16, 2017

HB 1549 Chair, Health and Government Operations Committee (By Request – Departmental – Health and Mental Hygiene)

PUBLIC HEALTH – DRUG OVERDOSE PREVENTION PROGRAMS – REVISIONS

Authorizing the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to deny, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew the registration of a person who manufactures, distributes, or dispenses a controlled dangerous substance in the State under specified conditions; requiring a local drug overdose fatality review team to review specified information and records related to a specified individual; providing the Overdose Response Program to authorize specified individuals to administer an opioid antagonist under specified circumstances; etc.

LANDLORD AND TENANT – ACTION FOR REPOSSESSION OF COMMERCIAL PROPERTY – SERVICE OF PROCESS

Creating an exception to the general requirements for service of process by a landlord on a tenant by authorizing service of process by any person authorized under the Maryland Rules to serve process if the action for repossession involves a commercial property.

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HB 1551 Prince George's County Delegation

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY LOCAL MANAGEMENT BOARD –
STRATEGIC PLAN AND REPORT PG 426–17

Requiring the Prince George's County Local Management Board to develop and implement a specified strategic plan and to submit the strategic plan to specified entities on or before January 1, 2018; authorizing the Prince George's County Local Management Board to apply for and accept donations, grants, or other financial assistance from specified entities; and requiring the Prince George's County Local Management Board to submit a report including specified information to specified entities on or before January 1 each year.

PUBLIC UTILITIES – TRANSPORTATION NETWORK SERVICES –
OPERATORS' LICENSES AND VEHICLE PERMITS

Requiring that a passenger motor vehicle used to provide transportation network services have a specified safety inspection certificate issued within 90 days after the first use of the vehicle to provide the services; prohibiting the Public Service Commission from denying an application for specified transportation network operators' licenses due to a criminal conviction or traffic violation that occurred more than 7 years before the application, with an exception; etc.

NONPROFIT HEALTH ENTITY – ACQUISITION – WAIVER OF
WAITING PERIOD

Authorizing the appropriate regulating entity, if it determines that waiving the waiting period under specified provisions of law is in the best interest of the public, to waive the 90-day waiting period between the date a determination is made on the acquisition of a nonprofit health entity and the date the determination takes effect.
