HOUSE BILLS INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 20, 2017

HB 1580 Delegate B. Barnes

STATE RETIREMENT AGENCY – INVESTMENT DIVISION
PERSONNEL

Authorizing the Board of Trustees for the State Retirement and Pension System to determine the qualifications and compensation of specified positions in the Investment Division in the State Retirement Agency; authorizing the Board of Trustees to create specified positions in the Investment Division; requiring specified positions to be funded from specified existing funds; requiring the Board of Trustees to report specified information to specified General Assembly committees on or before October 1 annually; etc.

HB 1581 Delegate Hayes, et al

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – CENTER STAGE

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Center Stage Associates, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, innovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Center Stage, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

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HB 1582 Delegate Luedtke, et al**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – FAMILY BEER AND WINE FACILITY PERMIT**

Repealing a provision of law that prohibits a family beer and wine facility permit holder from holding another license simultaneously.

HB 1583 Delegates Ali and Kaiser**INCOME TAX – EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT – NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY**

Requiring the Comptroller, beginning January 1, 2018, to provide specified written and electronic notice of the availability of credits against the State and federal income taxes for earned income; requiring that specified written notice be included in specified income tax return materials in a specified manner; requiring that specified electronic notice be posted on the Internet tax filing system of the Comptroller in a specified manner; requiring the Comptroller to adopt specified regulations; etc.

HB 1584 Delegate Angel**MARYLAND DENTISTRY ACT – SCOPE OF PRACTICE AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS**

Prohibiting a person from being considered to be practicing dentistry or violating specified provisions of law based solely on whether the person provides specified services or engages in specified acts; providing that specified provisions of law do not prohibit a dentist or dental practice from contracting to receive specified services or benefiting from specified acts; altering specified penalties for specified acts related to the unauthorized practice of dentistry; etc.

HB 1585 Delegate Szeliga, et al**BALTIMORE COUNTY – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – SUNDAY SALES**

Authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore County to grant a Sunday permit to a holder of a Class A beer, wine, and liquor license for an additional permit fee to be established by the Board; establishing that the permit authorizes the holder to sell alcoholic beverages for off-premises consumption on Sunday from 6 a.m. to midnight; submitting the Act to a referendum of the qualified voters of Baltimore County; requiring the Board to conduct a specified economic impact study; etc.

HB 1586 Delegate Lisanti**DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE – EMPLOYMENT IN THE STATE’S DEFENSE INDUSTRY – ARMY ALLIANCE STUDY**

Requiring the Department of Commerce, in conjunction with the Department of Veterans Affairs and the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation, to conduct a study on employment in the State’s defense industry; specifying the minimum requirements of the study; requiring the Department of Commerce to consult with specified entities; requiring the Department of Commerce to report, on or before December 31, 2017, to the General Assembly on the findings of the study; etc.

HB 1587 Washington County Delegation**COMMUNITY COLLEGES – OUT-OF-STATE FEE – WAIVER FOR BORDER STATE RESIDENTS**

Authorizing the boards of trustees of community colleges with service areas that border other states to set an out-of-state fee for students who reside in out-of-state counties that border Maryland; requiring that this fee be more than the out-of-county fee paid by Maryland students; allowing this fee to be less than the out-of-state fee paid by specified out-of-state students; prohibiting students attending community colleges by paying this fee from being counted for the purposes of specified State aid to community colleges; etc.

HB 1588 Delegates Fennell and Tarlau**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY – ST. ANN’S CENTER FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$50,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of St. Ann’s Center for Children, Youth and Families for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Hope House at St. Ann’s Center for Children, Youth and Families, located in Prince George’s County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

HB 1589 Delegate Busch**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY – HISTORIC ANNAPOLIS MUSEUM**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$90,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of Historic Annapolis, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the historic building serving as the Historic Annapolis Museum, located in Anne Arundel County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; etc.
