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## **HOUSE BILLS INTRODUCED MARCH 2, 2017**

### **HB 1633 Delegate J. Lewis, et al**

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY –  
CAPITOL HEIGHTS MUNICIPAL MULTISERVICE CENTER

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$350,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Capitol Heights for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping related to the Capitol Heights Municipal Multiservice Center, located in Prince George’s County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS – PUBLIC  
SCHOOL SYSTEM – REPORTS

Requiring the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners to report specified information relating to the Baltimore City Public School System to the Mayor of Baltimore City, the Baltimore City Council, and the Baltimore City Delegation to the General Assembly on or before December 1 each year.

Altering the information required to be in a specified annual report provided by the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and the members of the Baltimore City Delegation to the General Assembly to include the number of sworn Hispanic American police Officers in the Department, the number of sworn officers assigned to the Community Collaboration Division, and the fiscal year budget allocation for the Community Collaboration Division.

**HB 1636 Prince George’s County Delegation****PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY – SCHOOL FACILITIES AND PUBLIC SAFETY SURCHARGES – MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION STATION PG 430–17**

Establishing reductions from the school facilities surcharge and the public safety surcharge in Prince George’s County for specified residential construction that abuts an existing or planned mass transit rail station site operated by the Maryland Transit Administration; establishing 50% reduction and an exemption from the school facilities surcharge for specified dwelling units that are located within one-quarter mile of a Purple Line station under specified circumstances; etc.

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$800,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Bon Secours of Maryland Foundation, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Bon Secours Youth Development Center, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

**HB 1638 Delegate Haynes****EMPLOYEE OWNERSHIP TRUSTS**

Authorizing the creation of employee ownership trusts; providing for the exclusive purpose of an employee ownership trust; requiring the trustee of an employee ownership trust to carry out the express terms and purposes of the trust; providing, under specified circumstances, for the distribution of the principal or income of an employee ownership trust; authorizing specified tax benefits, procurement preferences, loan guarantees, and promotion activities to encourage the creation of employee ownership arrangements; etc.
