HOUSE BILLS INTRODUCED MARCH 3, 2017

HB 1639 Delegate S. Howard, et al

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY –
MANDRIN INPATIENT CARE CENTER

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Hospice of the Chesapeake, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Mandrin Inpatient Care Center facility, located in Anne Arundel County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

HB 1640 Delegate Glenn, et al

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – HISTORIC
DIAMOND PRESS BUILDING

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$300,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Historic East Baltimore Community Action Coalition, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Historic Diamond Press Building, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; etc.

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HB 1641 Delegate Lam**CORPORATIONS AND ASSOCIATIONS – NONPROFIT
CORPORATIONS – LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY**

Requiring that a specified nonprofit corporation that publicly advocates for or against legislation pending before the General Assembly or a county governing body record the corporation's position in the minutes for the meeting at which the decision is made to advocate for or against the legislation.

HB 1642 Delegate Flanagan**UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE – CHARGE OF BENEFITS – WAIVER
DUE TO NATURAL DISASTER**

Authorizing the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to waive the charge of benefits against the earned rating record of an employing unit if the benefits are paid to a claimant during a specified period of unemployment because the employing unit shut down due to a natural disaster and the Governor declared a state of emergency due to the natural disaster; and providing that the waiver may be in effect only for a specified period.
