EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION – SEXUAL HARASSMENT –
DEFINITION OF EMPLOYER

Altering the definition of “employer” for purposes of a complaint alleging sexual harassment by reducing from 15 to 1 the minimum number of employees an employer has; and providing that the Act preempts or prevails over specified local laws that require that an employer have more than one employee for purposes of a complaint alleging employment discrimination based on sexual harassment.

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – NATIONAL
GREAT BLACKS IN WAX MUSEUM

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$800,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of The National Great Blacks in Wax Museum, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the National Great Blacks in Wax Museum, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.
