HOUSE BILL INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 13, 2018

HB 1671 Frederick County Delegation

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – FREDERICK COUNTY – BRUNSWICK JUNIOR RAILROADERS

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$20,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Brunswick Junior Railroaders Boosters, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Brunswick Junior Railroaders youth sports facility, located in Frederick County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Executive and County Council of Anne Arundel County for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of a turf field at Chesapeake High School, located in Anne Arundel County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$150,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the City Neighbors Charter School, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Malone Children Memorial Playground and Community Park, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Chesapeake Region Accessible Boating, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of a marina for the Annapolis Adaptive Boating Center, located in Anne Arundel County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

CITY OF ANNAPOLIS – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES – BOOKSTORE LICENSE

Establishing a bookstore beer and wine license in the City of Annapolis; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue the license to a certain establishment; specifying that the license authorizes the license holder to sell beer and wine to a bookstore customer for on-premises consumption during a public lecture, reading, discussion, or similar bookstore event; prohibiting the average daily receipts from the sale of alcoholic beverages at the bookstore from exceeding 17% of average daily receipts; etc.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE – ADMINISTRATION OF OPIOID ANTIDOTES – IMMUNITY

Applying certain immunity from civil liability for certain acts or omissions to certain persons who administer to individuals who appear to be experiencing an opioid overdose a certain dose or certain doses of a certain opioid antidote.

HB 1007 Delegate Cullison**HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION ACT – BOARDS OF DIRECTORS, VOTING, MEETINGS, RECORDATION, AND RULES**

Altering the fee which a homeowners association may impose for a certain inspection from \$50 to \$100; establishing that a homeowners association shall be composed of all lot owners and that the bylaws may authorize the delegation of any power of the homeowners association; establishing certain powers of the board of directors of a homeowners association; requiring certain notice of certain meetings be provided to members of a homeowners association a certain period of time before the meeting and in a certain manner; etc.

HB 1098 Delegate Korman, et al**CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT**

Authorizing, instead of requiring, an appropriation for the Commission for the Workforce Development Sequence Scholarship; establishing the Career and Technology Education Grant Program to provide grants for the capital equipping of school facilities used to provide a certain career and technology program; requiring the Interagency Committee on School Construction to implement and administer the Program; terminating certain provisions of the Act after June 30, 2026; etc.

HB 1536 Delegate Hixson, et al

HIGHER EDUCATION – TUITION RATES – EXEMPTIONS

Altering the circumstances under which certain individuals are exempt from paying the out-of-state tuition rate at public institutions of higher education; altering the circumstances under which certain individuals are eligible to pay the resident tuition rate at a public senior higher education institution or the in-county rate at a community college; requiring a certain individual to remain exempt from paying certain tuition rates until the individual is awarded a certain degree under certain circumstances; etc.
