HOUSE BILLS INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 28, 2018

HB 1777 Delegate Szeliga

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE COUNTY – THE GLENN L. MARTIN MARYLAND AVIATION MUSEUM

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of The Glenn L. Martin Maryland Aviation Museum, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of The Glenn L. Martin Maryland Aviation Museum, located in Baltimore County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY – FORT WASHINGTON BAPTIST CHURCH

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Fort Washington Baptist Church for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Fort Washington Baptist Church facility, located in Prince George's County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

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HB 1779 Delegate Vallario, et al**JUDGES – MANDATORY RETIREMENT AGE**

Proposing an amendment to the Maryland Constitution increasing to 73 years from 70 years the mandatory retirement age for judges under certain circumstances; proposing an addition to the Maryland Constitution to provide for the application of certain amendments to the Maryland Constitution; submitting the amendment to the qualified voters of the State for their adoption or rejection; etc.

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT – CONTINGENT

Maryland Constitution, Art. IV, §§ 3, 3A, 5A(c) through (g), and 41D - amended and § 18B - repealed and added

HB 1780 Delegates Sample–Hughes and Carozza**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – WICOMICO COUNTY – ROTARY LABYRINTH**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$100,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Rotary Club of Salisbury Foundation, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Rotary Labyrinth project, located in Wicomico County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

HB 1781 Delegate S. Howard**LAND USE – CHANGE TO ZONING CLASSIFICATION – LIMITATION**

Specifying that a finding by a legislative body that a commercial or industrial activity associated with agritourism or agritainment takes place on a property is not sufficient justification for the legislative body to grant an amendment to change the zoning classification for the property, a property adjacent to the property, or a property in close proximity to the property.

HB 1782 Delegates Pena–Melnyk and Pendergrass

HEALTH INSURANCE – HEALTH CARE ACCESS PROGRAM – ESTABLISHMENT (MARYLAND HEALTH CARE ACCESS ACT OF 2018)

Requiring the State Health Services Cost Review Commission, for fiscal year 2019, to assess on each hospital a uniform, broad-based, and reasonable fee to support the Health Care Access Program established by the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange; requiring a carrier to pay a certain assessment on certain premiums beginning January 1, 2019; requiring certain health insurance entities to pay an additional assessment; requiring, beginning January 1, 2019, an individual to maintain certain coverage for certain individuals; etc.

EMERGENCY BILL

HG, § 19-214(d) and IN, § 31-107 - amended, IN and TG, Various Sections - added, and IN, § 31-117 - repealed
