### **HB 1824 Prince George's County Delegation**

PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY – MARRIAGE LICENSE FEES –  
DISTRIBUTION OF PROCEEDS PG 433–18

Requiring the Director of Finance of Prince George's County to distribute the proceeds from the additional marriage license fee to battered spouse shelters and domestic violence programs in accordance with the criteria and procedures established by the Prince George's County Department of Social Services.

PUBLIC INFORMATION – COURT RECORDS – NAME OF LAW  
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

Prohibiting a custodian of a public record that is a court record from preventing remote access to the last name and the initial of the first name of a law enforcement officer acting in the officer's official capacity in certain actions.
