HOUSE BILLS INTRODUCED MARCH 19, 2018

HB 1830 Delegates B. Barnes and Pena–Melnyk

HIGHER EDUCATION – MARYLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE
UNIVERSAL SCHOLARSHIPS – ESTABLISHED

Establishing the Maryland Community College Universal Scholarship program; requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance in the Maryland Higher Education Commission to publicize the availability of the scholarships; requiring the Office to annually select and offer a certain scholarship award to certain applicants; establishing the eligibility requirements for receiving a certain scholarship; requiring a certain community college to assist certain applicants with a certain application on request; etc.

This bill requires a mandated appropriation in the annual budget bill.

OFFENSES RELATING TO WEAPONS – REPORT**

Requiring the Baltimore County Public Schools Superintendent to submit a certain report on student misconduct offenses relating to weapons to the Baltimore County Delegation to the General Assembly on or before December 1, 2018, and each year thereafter; and requiring the report to include the number of misconduct offenses relating to weapons committed by a student at each public school in Baltimore County during a certain period of time.
