SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 20, 2018

SB 1179 Senator Conway (By Request – Baltimore City Administration) and Senator McFadden

BALTIMORE CITY – LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS’ BILL OF RIGHTS – HEARING BOARD

Providing that a law enforcement officer who receives probation before judgment for certain charges is not entitled to a hearing under the Law Enforcement Officers’ Bill of Rights; providing for the selection and composition of a hearing board in Baltimore City; excluding Baltimore City from a certain provision allowing for an alternative method for forming a hearing board under the Law Enforcement Officers’ Bill of Rights when the alternative method has been agreed to under certain collective bargaining agreements; etc.

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SB 1180 Senator Ferguson**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – AMERICAN VISIONARY ART MUSEUM**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of The American Visionary Art Museum, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Jim Rouse Visionary Center at the American Visionary Art Museum, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

SB 1181 Senator Ferguson**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – PATTERSON PARK**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Friends of Patterson Park, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Superintendent's House and a community programming space at Patterson Park, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide a matching fund; etc.

SB 1182 Senator Ferguson**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – BALTIMORE CITY – CREATIVE ALLIANCE**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Creative Alliance, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Creative Alliance facility, located in Baltimore City; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.

SB 1183 Senator Ferguson**PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION ASSESSMENT AND MAINTENANCE REFORM ACT**

Requiring the Interagency Committee on School Construction to develop and adopt certain educational facilities sufficiency standards, to create the Maryland School Facility Condition Index, and to conduct a statewide facility assessment on or before January 1, 2020, and annually thereafter; requiring the Interagency Committee to establish rankings based on certain criteria; requiring certain conditions for the statewide facility assessment; requiring the Interagency Committee to compare certain data; etc.

SB 1184 Senator Ferguson**CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – HABITAT FOR HUMANITY OF THE CHESAPEAKE**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Habitat for Humanity of the Chesapeake, Inc. for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Habitat for Humanity of the Chesapeake homes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; etc.
