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## SENATE BILLS INTRODUCED February 28, 2018

### **SB 1218 Senator Smith**

#### ENDING YOUTH HOMELESSNESS ACT OF 2018

Establishing the Ending Youth Homelessness Grant Program to focus on preventing and ending youth homelessness in the State and addressing disparities based on race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, and gender identity; requiring the Department of Housing and Community Development to administer the Program and provide funds to housing and supportive services for at risk and unaccompanied homeless youth; establishing the Ending Youth Homelessness Grant Fund as a special nonlapsing fund; etc.

### **SB 1219 Senator Kagan**

#### CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – MONTGOMERY COUNTY – ROCKVILLE WELCOME CENTER

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$150,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of CASA de Maryland, Inc. and the County Executive and County Council of Montgomery County for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Rockville Welcome Center facility, located in Montgomery County; providing for the disbursement of the loan proceeds; etc.

**SB 1220 Senator Muse****CREATION OF A STATE DEBT – PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY – CAMP SPRINGS ELKS LODGE NO. 2332**

Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$25,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Camp Springs Elks Lodge No. 2332, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States of America, Incorporated for the acquisition, planning, design, construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction, site improvement, and capital equipping of the Camp Springs Elks Lodge No. 2332, located in Prince George’s County; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; etc.

**SB 1221 Senator Serafini****PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION – INCENTIVE PROGRAM AND PILOT PROGRAM – ESTABLISHED**

Requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt regulations that establish per-pupil State school construction funding amounts under certain conditions; requiring the Interagency Committee on School Construction to conduct by January 1, 2019, an initial statewide facilities assessment; establishing the Public School Facility Construction Incentive Program; establishing the Public School Facility Construction Pilot Program to encourage innovative public school facility construction projects; etc.

Preliminary analysis: local government mandate

**SB 1222 Senator Klausmeier****EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE – ADMINISTRATION OF OPIOID ANTIDOTES – IMMUNITY**

Applying certain immunity from civil liability for certain acts or omissions to certain persons who administer to individuals who appear to be experiencing an opioid overdose a certain dose or certain doses of a certain opioid antidote.

**SB 1223** Senator Klausmeier**CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES REGISTRATION –  
AUTHORIZED PROVIDERS – CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION**

Requiring an authorized provider to submit certain evidence to the Maryland Department of Health that the authorized provider completed two credits of continuing medical education before the authorized provider may be registered by the Department to dispense a controlled dangerous substance; requiring certain continuing medical education to be related to the dispensing of controlled dangerous substances and developed by organizations accredited by a certain organization; etc.

**SENATE BILL REASSIGNED February 27, 2018****SB 1202** Senator Peters, et al**HIGHER EDUCATION – RICHARD W. COLLINS III LEADERSHIP WITH  
HONOR SCHOLARSHIP – ESTABLISHMENT**

Establishing the Richard W. Collins III Leadership With Honor Scholarship Program; establishing eligibility criteria for the scholarship that requires an individual to be a member of the Reserve Officer Training Corps, a certain minority student, and a student at a historically black college or university; requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance in the Maryland Higher Education Commission to award 25% of its grant money to students at Bowie State University and 75% to certain other colleges and universities; etc.

This bill requires a mandated appropriation in the annual budget bill.
