SB 1252 Senators Peters and Jennings

EMPLOYEES' AND TEACHERS' RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEMS – REEMPLOYMENT EARNINGS LIMITATION

Correcting certain requirements pertaining to a certain earnings limitation to certain retirees of the Employees' and Teachers' Retirement and Pension Systems; exempting certain retirees from a certain earnings limitation under certain circumstances; requiring certain participating employers to pay a certain offset under certain circumstances; providing that certain retirees are entitled to certain reimbursement for a certain reemployment earnings offset under certain circumstances; etc.

SB 1254 Senator RamirezCRIMINAL LAW – CRIMES RELATED TO LICENSED GAMING –
PENALTIES

Prohibiting a person from cheating at a certain game; prohibiting a person from altering or misrepresenting the outcome of a certain game under certain circumstances; prohibiting a person from placing, increasing, or decreasing a bet or determining the course of certain play after acquiring certain knowledge; prohibiting a person from claiming, collecting, or taking or attempting to claim, collect, or take money or anything of value in or from a certain game, with intent to defraud, under certain circumstances; etc.
