SENATE BILL INTRODUCED *March 17, 2018*

SB 1268 Senator Middleton

CRIMINAL PROCEDURE – LIFETIME SEXUAL OFFENDER SUPERVISION – VIOLATIONS AND PETITIONS FOR DISCHARGE

Requiring a sexual offender management team to report a violation of a condition of lifetime sexual offender supervision to the office of a certain State's Attorney; requiring a certain judge to conduct a certain hearing; authorizing a certain judge to act in a certain matter under certain circumstances; requiring a certain sentencing court to adjudicate rather than hear and adjudicate a certain petition; altering the time period before a certain petition may be renewed after being denied; etc.

SB 1152 Carroll County Senators

PUBLIC SAFETY – AGRITOURISM – PERMIT EXEMPTION

Adding Carroll County to the list of counties that exempt agricultural buildings engaged in agritourism from a certain permit requirement; providing for the number of people allowed to occupy a building engaged in agritourism in Carroll County under certain circumstances; and making a technical correction.
