AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1091
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after “students;” insert “requiring the county board to coordinate with the Instructional Resources Center within the State Department of Education to provide instructional materials in a specialized format to blind or visually impaired students not later than a certain day in the upcoming school year;”; and in line 12, after “Center” insert “at a certain time”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 30 through 34, inclusive.

On page 5, in line 8, after “**(6)**” insert “**(I)**”; strike beginning with “**PUBLISHER**” in line 8 down through “**MANNER**” in line 11 and substitute “**COUNTY BOARD SHALL REQUIRE IN ANY CONTRACT WITH A PUBLISHER OF PUPIL EDITION TEXTBOOKS, THAT THE PUBLISHER PROVIDE AN ELECTRONIC FILE OF THE TEXTBOOK IN THE NIMAS STANDARD TO THE NATIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS ACCESS CENTER AT THE SAME TIME THAT THE PUBLISHER PROVIDES THE TEXTBOOKS.**”

(II) THE DEPARTMENT AND COUNTY BOARDS SHALL ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH;

in line 18, strike “**AND**”; and in line 19, after “**(II)**” insert “**THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS REQUESTING INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS;**”

(III) THE GRADE LEVEL OF STUDENTS REQUESTING INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS;

(IV) THE NUMBER OF REQUESTS FOR INSTRUCTIONAL
MATERIALS IN A SPECIALIZED FORMAT THAT COULD BE FULFILLED; AND
