AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 837

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Pasteur**” and substitute “**Pasteur, Attar, Atterbeary, Ebersole, Fair, Feldmark, Griffith, Grossman, Henson, R. Long, Miller, Mireku–North, Palakovich Carr, Patterson, Roberts, Vogel, Wells, Wilkins, Wims, and Young**”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 3 down through “employers;” in line 7; strike beginning with “pay” in line 9 down through “circumstances” in line 10 and substitute “assist public high schools in a certain task”; in line 11, strike “and apprenticeships” and substitute “opportunities”; and strike in their entirety lines 17 through 21, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “**IN**” in line 2 down through “**(C)**” in line 18; in line 24, strike the second “**AND**”; and in line 26, after “**BOARDS**” insert “**; AND**”

(3) SCHOOLS LICENSED BY THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION THAT PROVIDE TRAINING, RETRAINING, OR ENHANCEMENT IN EMPLOYMENT SKILLS.

(B) WHEN INFORMING STUDENTS ABOUT OPPORTUNITIES UNDER THIS SECTION, EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL SHALL HIGHLIGHT OPPORTUNITIES IN HIGH-SKILLED CAREERS THAT DO NOT REQUIRE COMPLETION OF A COLLEGE DEGREE AND ARE IN HIGH DEMAND IN THE STATE.

(C) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ASSIST PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN COMPLETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION”.
