AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, after the first “of” insert “altering the definition of relative to mean an individual who is a kinship caregiver for purposes of provisions of law relating to children in need of assistance;”; and after line 5, insert:

(a) In this subtitle, the following words have the meanings indicated.

(x) “Relative” means an individual who is A KINSHIP CAREGIVER, AS DEFINED IN § 5–534 OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE[:

(1) Related to the child by blood or marriage within five degrees of consanguinity or affinity under the civil law; and

(2) (i) At least 21 years old; or

(ii) 1. At least 18 years old; and
