1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Disabled Veteran Registration Plates – Issuance**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue certain special
4 disabled veteran registration plates to certain disabled veterans; prohibiting the
5 Administration from charging certain persons the fee required for replacement
6 registration plates under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the
7 issuance of special disabled veteran registration plates.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Transportation**

2 (A) THE OWNER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE
3 UNDER A LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION
4 FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF SPECIAL DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATES
5 UNDER THIS SECTION FOR A VEHICLE INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING
6 CLASSES:

7 (1) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;

8 (2) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A 1 TON OR LESS
9 MANUFACTURER'S RATED CAPACITY;

10 (3) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE; OR

11 (4) A CLASS D (MOTORCYCLE) VEHICLE.

12 (B) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A SPECIAL DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION
13 PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION, AN APPLICANT SHALL PROVIDE PROOF THAT IS
14 SATISFACTORY TO THE ADMINISTRATION THAT THE APPLICANT IS AN ARMED
15 FORCES VETERAN WHO IS BETWEEN 50% AND 99%, INCLUSIVE,
16 SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABLED AS DESIGNATED OR CLASSIFIED BY THE U.S.
17 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

18 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL DISABLED VETERAN
19 REGISTRATION PLATE THAT DOES NOT DISPLAY THE INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL OF
20 ACCESS IN RECOGNITION OF THE VEHICLE OWNER'S SERVICE-CONNECTED
21 DISABILITY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AN ARMED FORCES VETERAN AND IS
22 BETWEEN 50% AND 99%, INCLUSIVE, SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABLED.

23 (D) THE ADMINISTRATION:

24 (1) SHALL CHARGE THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE AND
25 SURCHARGE OTHERWISE REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE FOR SPECIAL DISABLED
26 VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATES ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

27 (2) MAY NOT CHARGE OR RETAIN ANY ADDITIONAL FEE FOR THE
28 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES.

29 (E) SPECIAL DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATES ISSUED UNDER
30 THIS SECTION:

31 (1) MAY CONSIST OF ANY COMBINATION OF LETTERS, NUMERALS, OR

1 BOTH; AND

2 (2) SHALL STATE "DISABLED VETERAN" ON THE SPECIAL
3 REGISTRATION PLATES.

4 (F) (1) IF THE OWNERSHIP OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ASSIGNED SPECIAL
5 DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION IS TRANSFERRED
6 FROM THE DISABLED VETERAN WHO QUALIFIED FOR THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION
7 PLATES TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES NOT QUALIFY FOR THE SPECIAL
8 REGISTRATION PLATES:

9 (I) 1. THE TRANSFEROR SHALL RETURN THE SPECIAL
10 REGISTRATION PLATES TO THE ADMINISTRATION; AND

11 2. THE TRANSFEREE SHALL OBTAIN VEHICLE TITLE,
12 REGISTRATION, AND REGISTRATION PLATES AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND

13 (II) IF THE TRANSFEROR AND THE TRANSFEREE WERE JOINT
14 OWNERS OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE BEFORE THE TRANSFER, THE ADMINISTRATION
15 MAY NOT CHARGE THE TRANSFEREE THE FEE OTHERWISE REQUIRED FOR THE
16 REPLACEMENT OF REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER § 13-952 OF THIS TITLE.

17 (2) IF THE OWNERSHIP OF A MOTOR VEHICLE ASSIGNED SPECIAL
18 DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION IS TRANSFERRED
19 FROM THE DISABLED VETERAN WHO QUALIFIED FOR THE SPECIAL REGISTRATION
20 PLATES TO THE DISABLED VETERAN'S SPOUSE WHO DOES NOT QUALIFY FOR THE
21 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES:

22 (I) 1. THE TRANSFEROR SHALL RETURN THE SPECIAL
23 REGISTRATION PLATES TO THE ADMINISTRATION; AND

24 2. THE TRANSFEREE SHALL OBTAIN VEHICLE TITLE,
25 REGISTRATION, AND REGISTRATION PLATES AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND

26 (II) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CHARGE THE TRANSFEREE
27 THE FEE OTHERWISE REQUIRED FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF REGISTRATION PLATES
28 UNDER § 13-952 OF THIS TITLE.

29 (G) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO
30 GOVERN THE ISSUANCE OF THE SPECIAL DISABLED VETERAN REGISTRATION
31 PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.

1 (a) The following vehicles are exempt from the registration fees specified in this
2 subtitle:

3 (8) A vehicle owned by, or leased to, and personally used by a veteran who:

4 (i) As designated or classified by the Veterans' Administration, has
5 lost the use of a hand, arm, or leg, or is totally disabled; or

6 (ii) Has a permanent impairment of both eyes so that:

7 1. The central visual acuity is 20/200 or less in the better eye,
8 with corrective glasses; or

9 2. There is a field defect in which the peripheral field has
10 contracted to such an extent that the widest diameter of visual field subtends an angular
11 distance no greater than 20 degrees in the better eye;

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2024.
