2 **Business Regulation – Contractors, Subcontractors, and Brokers – Prohibited**
3 **Conduct**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from serving or acting as a contractor, a
5 subcontractor, or a broker between a contractor and subcontractor during a certain
6 period after the person was convicted of a certain offense under federal or state law;
7 and generally relating to contractors, subcontractors, and brokers.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Business Regulation**

16 **19–107.**

17 **A PERSON MAY NOT SERVE OR ACT AS A CONTRACTOR, A SUBCONTRACTOR, OR**
18 **A BROKER BETWEEN A CONTRACTOR AND SUBCONTRACTOR IN THE STATE DURING**
19 **THE 5–YEAR PERIOD IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE DATE THE PERSON WAS**
