12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Health – General**

15 [18–601.1.

16 (a) An individual who has the human immunodeficiency virus may not knowingly
17 transfer or attempt to transfer the human immunodeficiency virus to another individual.

18 (b) A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor
