
Business Regulation - Household Goods Movers - Special Fund and Fees

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Household Goods Movers Registration Fund as a 4 special, nonlapsing fund in the Maryland Department of Labor; requiring that 5 certain investment earnings be credited to the General Fund; requiring the Secretary 6 of Labor to annually calculate certain costs; authorizing the Department to set by 7 regulation certain fees based on certain calculations; prohibiting certain fees from 8 increasing by more than a certain amount each year; requiring that certain fees in effect on a certain date shall remain in effect until certain other fees are adopted and 9 become effective; and generally relating to the Household Goods Movers Registration 10 11 Fund.

- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 Article – Business Regulation

- 5 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE HOUSEHOLD GOODS MOVERS 6 REGISTRATION FUND.
- 7 (B) (1) THERE IS A HOUSEHOLD GOODS MOVERS REGISTRATION FUND 8 IN THE DEPARTMENT.
- 9 (2) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 10 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- 11 (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY ALL FEES COLLECTED UNDER 12 TITLE 8.5 OF THIS ARTICLE TO THE COMPTROLLER.
- 13 (2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FEES TO THE FUND.
- 14 (D) THE FUND SHALL BE USED TO COVER THE ACTUAL DOCUMENTED
- 15 DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF FULFILLING THE STATUTORY AND REGULATORY
- 16 DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT UNDER TITLE 8.5 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 17 (E) THE SECRETARY OR A DESIGNEE OF THE SECRETARY SHALL 18 ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- - 19 (F) THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR SHALL AUDIT THE ACCOUNTS AND
 - 20 TRANSACTIONS OF THE FUND AS PROVIDED IN § 2-1220 OF THE STATE
 - 21 GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
 - 22 (G) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE
 - 23 GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

 - 25 (A) THE SECRETARY SHALL ANNUALLY CALCULATE THE DIRECT AND

 - 28 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH FEES BASED ON THE

- 25 (A) (1) THE DEPARTMENT MAY SET BY REGULATION REASONABLE FEES FOR ITS SERVICES TO CARRY OUT THIS TITLE.
- 27 (2) THE FEES CHARGED SHALL BE:
- 28 (I) SET SO AS TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO APPROXIMATE THE COST 29 OF MAINTAINING THE DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS TITLE; AND

- 3 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH A SCHEDULE OF FEES SET BY THE 4 DEPARTMENT.
- 5 (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY ALL FEES COLLECTED UNDER THIS 6 TITLE TO THE COMPTROLLER.
- 7 (2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE FEES TO THE 8 HOUSEHOLD GOODS MOVERS REGISTRATION FUND ESTABLISHED IN § 2–106.15 OF 9 THIS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the fees set forth in Title 8.5 of the Business Regulation Article, in effect on June 30, 2024, shall remain in full force and effect until the fees authorized by the Maryland Department of Labor under this Act are adopted and become effective.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
