- FOR the purpose of altering the amount of an appropriation that the Governor is required 4 5 to include in the annual budget bill each year for the Tri-County Council for 6 Southern Maryland; repealing the termination of certain provisions of law that 7 require the Governor to include the appropriation in the annual budget bill each year 8 and the Council to use the appropriation to fund the activities of the Southern 9 Maryland Agricultural Development Commission; and generally relating to the 10 Tri-County Council for Southern Maryland and the Southern Maryland Agricultural 11 Development Commission.
