2 **Garrett County – Sheriff’s Salary – Alteration**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Garrett County; repealing the
4 requirement for the Garrett County Salary Study Commission to study and issue a
5 report that contains recommendations relating to the salary of the Sheriff; and
6 generally relating to the salary of the Sheriff of Garrett County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

17 2–325.

18 (a) This section applies only in Garrett County.

19 (b) (1) The Sheriff of Garrett County shall receive an annual salary [of:

20 (i) \$28,250 for calendar year 1991;

21 (ii) \$30,500 for calendar year 1992;

22 (iii) \$32,750 for calendar year 1993;

23 (iv) \$35,000 for calendar year 1994; and

24 (v) For each subsequent year, the salary set by the County
25 Commissioners of Garrett County in accordance with Chapter 91 of the Public Local Laws
26 of Garrett County] **THAT IS 80% OF THE SALARY OF THE STATE’S ATTORNEY OF**
27 **GARRETT COUNTY.**

30 There is a Garrett County Salary Study Commission.

2 (A) The Commission shall study the salaries of the:

3 (1) County Commissioners;

4 (2) Board of Education;

5 (3) Board of Supervisors of Elections;

6 (4) Judges of the Orphans' Court; **AND**

7 (5) Liquor Control Board[; and

8 (6) Sheriff].

9 (B) The Commission may recommend to the County Commissioners an increase
10 or decrease in the salary of the State's Attorney, or any office in division (A) of this section.

11 (C) The Commission shall report its recommendations to the County
12 Commissioners on or before June 30, 1997, and on or before June 30 every fourth year
13 thereafter.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, ~~in accordance with~~ *pursuant*
15 *to* Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend
16 or apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Garrett County while serving in a
17 term of office beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act
18 concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Garrett County shall take effect at
19 the beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an
20 individual appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired
21 term.

22 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 October 1, 2024.
