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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County and Montgomery County – The Washington Suburban**  
3 **Transit Commission Reform Act**

4 **PG/MC 103–24**

5 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Transportation's designee to attend  
6 meetings of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Board of Directors  
7 on behalf of the Secretary when the Secretary is not available; providing that the  
8 Secretary's designee has the same powers as the Secretary when attending meetings  
9 of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Board of Directors on behalf  
10 of the Secretary; authorizing the Washington Suburban Transit Commission to  
11 reappoint a certain appointee to be a principal member of the Washington  
12 Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Board of Directors; repealing a limitation that  
13 the Washington Suburban Transit District's authority to make and enter into all  
14 contracts or agreements the Commission determines are necessary is subject to the  
15 review and approval by the respective governing bodies of the counties; and generally  
16 relating to the Washington Suburban Transit Commission.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
 11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 **Article 16 – Montgomery County**

14 There is hereby created the Washington Suburban Transit Commission, which shall  
 15 have the powers and duties granted herein and such additional powers as may hereafter  
 16 lawfully be conferred upon it pursuant to law, to manage and control the functions, affairs  
 17 and property of the corporation.

19 (a) (14) (i) The following commissioners shall serve as the Commission's  
 20 appointees to be principal members of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit  
 21 Authority Board of Directors:

22 1. Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, the  
 23 Secretary of Transportation, or the Secretary's designee, as an ex officio principal member;  
 24 and

25 2. Subject to subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, one of the  
 26 commissioners appointed by the Governor under paragraph (4) of this subsection.

27 (ii) The Secretary of Transportation's designee under subparagraph  
 28 (i)1 of this paragraph:

29 1. Shall be an employee of the Department of  
 30 Transportation;

31 2. Shall have experience with and possess qualifications  
 32 related to transit; and

33 3. **A.** May attend meetings of the Washington  
 34 Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Board of Directors on behalf of the Secretary [only if

1 a scheduling conflict arises] **WHEN THE SECRETARY IS NOT AVAILABLE; AND**

2 **B. WHEN ATTENDING MEETINGS ON BEHALF OF THE**  
3 **SECRETARY, SHALL HAVE THE SAME POWERS AS THE SECRETARY.**

4 (iii) The Commission’s appointee under subparagraph (i)2 of this  
5 paragraph [may]:

6 **1. MAY BE REAPPOINTED; AND**

7 **2. MAY** not be succeeded in office by a commissioner who is  
8 a resident of the same county.

10 Without in any manner limiting or restricting the general powers created by this  
11 subtitle, the district shall have power:

12 (d) Subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of section 87–12 [and subject to the  
13 review and approval in whole or in part by the respective governing bodies of the counties],  
14 to make and enter into all contracts or agreements as the commission may determine which  
15 are necessary or incidental to the performance of its duties and to the execution of the  
16 powers granted under this chapter;

20 There is hereby created the Washington Suburban Transit Commission, which shall

25 (a) (14) (A) The following Commissioners shall serve as the Commission’s

22 review and approval in whole or in part by the respective governing bodies of the counties],  
23 to make and enter into all contracts or agreements as the Commission may determine  
24 which are necessary or incidental to the performance of its duties and to the execution of  
25 the powers granted under this Subtitle.

27 October 1, 2024.
