  26 GRANT FUNDING FROM THE PROGRAM; AND
- 27 (2) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SELECTING RECIPIENTS FOR GRANT 28 FUNDING FROM THE PROGRAM.

- 30 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE FORENSIC NURSE EXAMINER 31 TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM FUND.

- 1 (B) THERE IS A FORENSIC NURSE EXAMINER TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM 2 FUND.
- 3 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR GRANTS 4 AWARDED UNDER THE PROGRAM.
- 5 (D) THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF CRIME PREVENTION, YOUTH, AND 6 VICTIM SERVICES SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND.
- 7 (E) (1) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT 8 SUBJECT TO § 7–302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.
- 9 (2) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, 10 AND THE COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.
- 11 (F) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:
- 12 (1) REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FUND UNDER § 14–4602 OF THIS 13 SUBTITLE; AND
- 14 (2) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR 15 THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.
- 16 (G) THE FUND MAY BE USED ONLY TO FUND GRANTS TO NONPROFIT 17 ENTITIES THROUGH THE PROGRAM.
- 18 (H) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND 19 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
- 20 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO 21 THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
- 22 (I) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE 23 WITH THE STATE BUDGET.

- 27 (1) AN OFFENSE UNDER TITLE 3, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW

- 1 (2) THE SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR UNDER § 3-604 OF THE 2 CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE: OR
- 3 (3) THE SEXUAL ABUSE OF A VULNERABLE ADULT UNDER § 3–802 OF
  4 THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE.
- 5 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SEXUALLY ASSAULTIVE BEHAVIOR" HAS THE 6 MEANING STATED IN § 10–923 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 7 (B) EVIDENCE INFORMATION THAT PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OF A SEXUAL 8 CRIME SEXUALLY ASSAULTIVE BEHAVIOR WAS OBTAINED USING MATERIALS THAT 9 WERE SOLD, OFFERED FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTED IN A MANNER THAT WOULD 10 CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF § 14–4602 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE IS NOT 11 ADMISSIBLE IN A CRIMINAL OR CIVIL PROCEEDING INVOLVING AN ALLEGATION OF 12 A SEXUAL CRIME SEXUALLY ASSAULTIVE BEHAVIOR.
- 13 (C) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE A COURT TO ADMIT 14 PHYSICAL EVIDENCE.

- 28 **[(j)] (K)** The Attorney General shall adopt regulations for uniform statewide 29 implementation of this section.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 31 October 1, 2024 is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the
- 32 public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of
- 33 all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
- 34 *effect from the date it is enacted*.
