2 **State Board of Occupational Therapy Practice – Sunset Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Occupational Therapy Practice in
4 accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act by
5 extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and
6 regulatory authority of the Board; and generally relating to the State Board of
7 Occupational Therapy Practice.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program
5 Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall
6 terminate and be of no effect after July 1, **[2025] 2028**.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
8 1, 2024.
