## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Libraries – Regional Resource Centers – Governing Board Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of public members on the governing board for  
4 each regional resource center; and generally relating to the membership of governing  
5 boards for regional resource centers.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Education**

19 23–202.1.

20 (a) There is a governing board for each regional resource center.

21 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a governing  
22 board consists of the following members:

- 1 (i) A library trustee from each participating library system; and
- 2 (ii) Up to ~~[one member]~~ **TWO MEMBERS** of the public from each area  
3 served by the participating library systems.
- 4 (2) (i) The board of trustees of the Washington County Free Library  
5 shall act as the governing board for the Western Maryland Regional Resource Center.
- 6 (ii) The bylaws adopted by the board of trustees of the Washington  
7 County Free Library shall govern the composition, appointment, qualifications, terms, and  
8 structure of the governing board.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
10 1, 2024.
