- one member of the House of Delegates who is registered as a Democrat and a member of the Frederick County Delegation, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- 15 (3) one member of the Senate of Maryland who is registered as a 16 Republican and a member of the Frederick County Delegation, appointed by the President 17 of the Senate; and
- 18 (4) one member of the House of Delegates who is registered as a Republican 19 and a member of the Frederick County Delegation, appointed by the Speaker of the House.
