A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Self-Service Storage Act – Sale of Personal Property in Satisfaction of**
3 **Liens – Means of Advertising**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing an operator or a manager of a self-service storage facility
5 to advertise in a certain manner the sale of the personal property in a self-service
6 storage unit to satisfy a certain lien without the occupant's prior written
7 authorization in the storage agreement; and generally relating to self-service
8 storage units.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Commercial Law**

17 18-503.

18 (b) The rental agreement shall contain a statement, in bold type, advising the
19 occupant:

20 (4) That a sale of personal property stored in the leased space to satisfy the
21 lien if the occupant is in default may be advertised:

22 (i) In a newspaper of general circulation in the jurisdiction where
23 the sale is to be held;

4 (b) (4) [(i) Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, at] **AT** least 3
5 days before conducting a sale under this section, the operator shall advertise the time,
6 place, and terms of the sale:

7 [1.] **(I)** In a newspaper of general circulation in the
8 jurisdiction where the sale is to be held;

9 [2.] **(II)** By electronic mail; or

10 [3.] **(III)** On an online [Web site] **WEBSITE**.

11 [(ii) The operator may not advertise the sale in the manner provided
12 under subparagraph (i)2 or 3 of this paragraph unless the occupant provides the occupant's
13 initials next to the statement in the rental agreement required under § 18–503(b)(4) of this
14 subtitle.]

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2024.
