## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Part-Time Deputy Chief**  
3 **Inspector**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the annual salary of a part-time deputy chief inspector  
5 employed by the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County;  
6 establishing a workweek of a certain number of hours per week for the part-time  
7 deputy chief inspector; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages and the Board  
8 of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

22 11–102.

23 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

1 (a) (1) The Board may employ:

2 (i) one part-time deputy chief inspector:

3 1. at an annual salary of [~~\$9,000~~] **\$18,000; AND**

4 2. **WITH A WORKWEEK OF 10 HOURS PER WEEK;** and

5 (ii) 18 part-time inspectors at an annual salary of \$7,000 each.

6 (2) Each inspector shall receive a monthly expense allowance of \$300,  
7 subject to the approval of the Executive Director.

8 (b) An inspector:

9 (1) has all the powers of a peace officer or sheriff in the State arising out of  
10 or relating to the enforcement of this article;

11 (2) may serve a summons under § 11-2604 of this title; and

12 (3) may issue a civil citation under § 11-2605 of this title.

13 (c) An inspector shall take the oath required by Article I, § 9 of the Maryland  
14 Constitution.

15 (d) (1) An inspector shall provide a penalty bond of \$2,000 to the Board and  
16 the County Council jointly on the condition that the inspector faithfully perform the duties  
17 of office.

18 (2) The county shall pay the cost of the bond.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
20 1, 2024.
