## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Uniform Disposition of Abandoned Property Act – Maryland 529**  
3 **Program – Exemption**

4 FOR the purpose of exempting certain accounts under the Maryland 529 Program and  
5 certain sums payable from the accounts from the provisions of the Maryland Uniform  
6 Disposition of Abandoned Property Act; and generally relating to the Maryland  
7 Uniform Disposition of Abandoned Property Act.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – Commercial Law  
10 Section 17–104  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Commercial Law**

16 17–104.

17 This title does not apply to any property that [has]:

18 **(1) HAS** been presumed abandoned or escheated under the laws of another  
19 state before June 1, 1966; **OR**

20 **(2) IS CONTAINED IN AN ACCOUNT OR IS A SUM PAYABLE ON A CHECK**  
21 **DRAWN AGAINST AN ACCOUNT THAT WAS ESTABLISHED UNDER:**

22 **(i) TITLE 18, SUBTITLE 19 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE;**

1                   **(II) TITLE 18, SUBTITLE 19A OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE; OR**

3           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June  
4 1, 2024.
