- 15 (f) (1) Except as provided in [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) of this 16 subsection, before the county makes any disposition, grant, or lease of county property, the 17 county shall publish notice of the disposition, grant, or lease once a week for 3 successive
- 18 weeks in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the county and shall include the
- 19 terms and the compensation to be received and give opportunity for objections.
- 20 (2) A county may grant an easement for a public utility without giving
