4 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of “local government” under the Local
5 Government Tort Claims Act to include the Hagerstown Multi-Use Sports and
6 Events Facility, Inc., in Washington County; and generally relating to the Local
7 Government Tort Claims Act.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

2 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

3 (d) “Local government” means:

4 (1) A charter county as defined in § 1–101 of the Local Government Article;

5 (2) A code county as defined in § 1–101 of the Local Government Article;

6 (3) A board of county commissioners;

7 (4) Baltimore City;

8 (5) A municipality as defined in § 1–101 of the Local Government Article;

9 (6) The Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission;

10 (7) The Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission;

11 (8) The Northeast Maryland Waste Disposal Authority;

12 (9) A community college or board of trustees for a community college
13 established or operating under Title 16 of the Education Article, not including Baltimore
14 City Community College;

15 (10) A county public library or board of trustees of a county public library
16 established or operating under Title 23, Subtitle 4 of the Education Article;

17 (11) The Enoch Pratt Free Library or Board of Trustees of the Enoch Pratt
18 Free Library;

19 (12) The Washington County Free Library or the Board of Trustees of the
20 Washington County Free Library;

21 (13) A special taxing district;

22 (14) A nonprofit community service corporation incorporated under State
23 law that is authorized to collect charges or assessments;

24 (15) Housing authorities created under Division II of the Housing and
25 Community Development Article;

26 (16) A sanitary district, sanitary commission, metropolitan commission, or
27 other sewer or water authority established or operating under public local law or public
28 general law;

1 (17) A regional development council;

2 (18) The Howard County Economic Development Authority;

3 (19) The Howard County Mental Health Authority;

4 (20) A commercial district management authority established by a county
5 or municipal corporation if provided under local law;

6 (21) The Baltimore City Police Department;

7 (22) A regional library resource center or a cooperative library corporation
8 established under Title 23, Subtitle 2 of the Education Article;

9 (23) Lexington Market, Inc., in Baltimore City;

10 (24) The Baltimore Public Markets Corporation, in Baltimore City;

11 (25) A nonprofit corporation serving as the local public transportation
12 authority for Carroll County pursuant to a contract or memorandum of understanding with
13 Carroll County;

14 (26) The nonprofit corporation serving as the animal control and licensing
15 authority for Carroll County pursuant to a contract or memorandum of understanding with
16 Carroll County (the Humane Society of Carroll County, Inc.);

17 (27) Garrett County Municipalities, Inc., in Garrett County;

18 (28) The nonprofit corporation serving as the local public transportation
19 authority for Garrett County pursuant to a contract or memorandum of understanding with
20 Garrett County (Garrett County Community Action Committee, Inc.); [and]

21 (29) The nonprofit corporation serving as the industrial development
22 authority of Carroll County established under Title 12, Subtitle 1 of the Economic
23 Development Article; AND

24 **(30) THE HAGERSTOWN MULTI-USE SPORTS AND EVENTS FACILITY,**
25 **INC., IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.**

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 2024.
