The purpose of this project is to analyze the capacity of the existing stormwater infrastructure in design and implement measures for the safe conveyance of stormwater and to reduce the risk of flooding to property and infrastructure. The City in collaboration with the USACOE has completed flood studies within various locations throughout the City. Based upon the recommendations found within these studies, flood mitigation projects are proceeding with design and future construction in for the West Patrick Street at Maryvale Ditch adjacent to West Frederick Middle School.
