Upgrade lighting to more energy saving fixture. replacing the drop ceiling in our lounge will be more energy efficient as well as enhance acoustics, Lower and replace ceilings to promote energy efficiency and have better acoustics. Replacing the aging floor tiles will make a more welcoming facility.
