# Appropriations Committee Witness Guidelines 2024 Session

All bill hearings will be held in-person with a virtual oral testimony option (via Zoom) and streamed live on YouTube. If you would like to provide oral testimony, in-person is strongly encouraged.

**Budget Hearings – there is NO virtual option.** 

### Sign-Up:

Oral testimony sign-up and written testimony (must be a PDF document) submission must be done using MyMGA on the <u>Maryland General Assembly website home page</u> (see icon on the upper right corner of home page). MyMGA works optimal on Chrome or Microsoft Edge browsers; for Apple devices on Safari.

Late testimony can be emailed to <a>AA</a> <a>APP@mlis.state.md.us</a>

If you choose to testify virtually, you <u>MUST</u> enter a valid email address to receive the zoom link to access the hearing.

There is NO switching from in-person to virtual or vice versa once the sign-up period has closed.

Oral and written testimony sign-up is open for 9 hours, 2 business days before a scheduled hearing and opens at 8:00 am and closes at 6:00 pm.

There will be **NO presentations, videos, or PowerPoints**.

#### **Bill Hearings:**

Every on-time bill will receive a hearing. The committee chair will continue to have full discretion over the length of the hearing. The hearing schedule will be posted the week before the hearing is scheduled, or earlier if possible. It is difficult to change bill hearing dates after they have been announced in the hearing schedule. Such changes inconvenience the interested public and will be authorized by the Chair only in unusual circumstances. Advance requests to have a bill heard on a certain date can be made through the Chair's Chief of Staff.

Witnesses are urged NOT to read prepared testimony or to repeat prior testimony. To expedite the hearing and allow all witnesses an opportunity to be heard, the Chair has the prerogative to limit questions from the members or the time for witnesses to testify.

### **In-person Witnesses:**

The screens in the main lobby outside of the Appropriations Committee room will display the live hearing with closed captions and along with bill status.

## **Virtual Witnesses for Bill Hearings:**

The Zoom link will be sent no later than one business day prior to scheduled hearing date. Prior to joining the hearing, please ensure your display name matches the first and last name used to sign up. To enter the hearing, click the provided link to place you in the "waiting room." The host will see the correct name and will admit you once called upon by the Chair.

You will be unable to hear or see the Zoom hearing when you are in the waiting room. You must watch the hearing via the YouTube live stream found on the <u>MGA website homepage</u> to follow along with the hearing. The YouTube streaming window must be closed when you are entering the Zoom hearing to prevent disruptive feedback/echo sound.

After your bill is heard, you will be removed from the Zoom hearing. If you have another bill being heard on the same date but at a later time, please click the link in your email again to rejoin.
