AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 110

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in lines 15 and 16, strike “: (1)”; in lines 17, 20, 23, 30, 32, and 35, strike “(I)”, “(II)”, “(III)”, “(IV)”, “1.”, and “2.”, respectively, and substitute “(1)”, “(2)”, “(3)”, “(4)”, “(I)”, and “(II)”, respectively; in line 23, strike the colon; in line 24, strike “1.”; strike beginning with “AND” in line 26 down through “REGULATION;” in line 29; in line 33, strike “(I)” and substitute “(1)”; and in the same line, strike “(III)” and substitute “(3)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 30, before “PUBLISHES” insert “EXCEPT FOR A PROPOSED REGULATION SUBMITTED FOR EMERGENCY ADOPTION UNDER § 10-111(B) OF THIS ARTICLE.”.

On page 3, in line 3, strike “(V)” and substitute:

“(5) EXCEPT FOR A PROPOSED REGULATION SUBMITTED FOR EMERGENCY ADOPTION UNDER § 10-111(B) OF THIS ARTICLE.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 5, strike “; AND” and substitute a period; and strike in their entirety lines 6 through 11, inclusive, and substitute:

“(B) (1) EXCEPT FOR A PROPOSED REGULATION SUBMITTED FOR EMERGENCY ADOPTION UNDER § 10-111(B) OF THIS ARTICLE, IF THE COMMITTEE DECIDES BY MAJORITY VOTE TO CONDUCT A HEARING ON A PROPOSED REGULATION UNDER THIS SECTION, THE HEARING SHALL BE HELD NOT LATER THAN 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE THAT THE NOTICE OF THE PROPOSED REGULATION IS PUBLISHED IN THE MARYLAND REGISTER.

(Over)

(2) IF THE COMMITTEE FAILS TO HOLD A HEARING UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE UNIT MAY PROCEED TO ADOPT THE PROPOSED REGULATION.”.

On page 3, in line 16, strike “45” and substitute “10”.
