AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1050

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, strike “and” and substitute “requiring a study and report;”; and in the same line, after “measure” insert “; and providing for the termination of certain provisions of this Act”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 22, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland State Board of Education shall undertake a study of required school days and holidays, and report to the General Assembly with recommendations by January 1, 1997. The study shall include, among other aspects, holidays such as Good Friday, Easter Monday, and primary and general election days.”;

in line 23, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”; and after line 27, insert:

“SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall remain effective until the end of June 30, 1996, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
