## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after "<u>County</u>;" insert "<u>establishing certain conditions for the issuance of a certain class of license for certain businesses</u>;".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 7, in line 27, after "County]" insert:

## "(1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY";

in line 28, strike "COUNTY," and substitute "COUNTY.

- (2) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR A GROCERY STORE, CONVENIENCE STORE, OR DRUGSTORE IF THE ESTABLISHMENT HAS BEEN DOING BUSINESS IN THE COUNTY FOR MORE THAN 1 YEAR PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE.
- (3) IF THE LICENSE IS ISSUED FOR A BUSINESS DESCRIBED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SHALL BE DISPLAYED AND PURCHASED IN AN AREA SEPARATE AND DISTINCT FROM THAT OF THE OTHER RETAIL ITEMS.
- (4) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY REQUIRE PARTITIONS IF DEEMED CONDUCIVE TO THE INTENT OF PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
