AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 60

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after "County;" insert "establishing certain conditions for the issuance of a certain class of license for certain businesses;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 7, in line 27, after "County]" insert:

"(1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY";

in line 28, strike "COUNTY," and substitute "COUNTY.

(2) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED FOR A GROCERY STORE, CONVENIENCE STORE, OR DRUGSTORE IF THE ESTABLISHMENT HAS BEEN DOING BUSINESS IN THE COUNTY FOR MORE THAN 1 YEAR PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THE APPLICATION FOR THE LICENSE.

(3) IF THE LICENSE IS ISSUED FOR A BUSINESS DESCRIBED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SHALL BE DISPLAYED AND PURCHASED IN AN AREA SEPARATE AND DISTINCT FROM THAT OF THE OTHER RETAIL ITEMS.

(4) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY REQUIRE PARTITIONS IF DEEMED CONDUCTIVE TO THE INTENT OF PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
