On page 2, in line 11, strike "SECTION" and substitute "SUBTITLE"; and after line 28, insert:

## "8-6A-02.

ON DECEMBER 1, 2000, AND EACH DECEMBER 1 THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE TO THE SENATE ECONOMIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON:

(1) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF INMATES WHO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS BEFORE RELEASE AND PARTICIPATED IN AFTERCARE FOLLOW-UP TREATMENT AFTER RELEASE IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 8-6A-01 OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) THE NUMBER OF INMATES CURRENTLY PARTICIPATING IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS BEFORE RELEASE AND PARTICIPATING IN AFTERCARE FOLLOW-UP TREATMENT AFTER RELEASE IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 8-6A-01 OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(3) THE TOTAL COST OF THE ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAM SERVICES PROVIDED TO INMATES, INCLUDING THE COST OF AFTERCARE FOLLOW-UP TREATMENT; AND

(4) THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS WHO ARE REARRESTED WHO HAVE PARTICIPATED IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE TREATMENT PROGRAMS BEFORE RELEASE AND AFTERCARE FOLLOW-UP TREATMENT AFTER RELEASE.".
