## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 903

(First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Child in Need of Supervision Petition" and substitute "Investigation and Reporting Requirements"; in lines 4 and 5, strike "absent more than a certain number of times in 1 month," and substitute "habitually truant without lawful excuse,"; strike beginning with "or" in line 6 down through "supervision" in line 7 and substitute "; authorizing the officials to provide certain services and to notify the Department of Juvenile Justice that the student has been habitually truant; requiring certain school officials to provide to a local education agency certain information on certain students described as habitually truant; and generally relating to education and truancy"; and in line 10, after "7-302" insert "and 7-303(e)".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 24, strike "OR PRIVATE"; in lines 24 and 25, strike "ABSENT 10 OR MORE DAYS IN 1 MONTH WITHOUT A MEDICAL" and substitute "<u>HABITUALLY TRUANT WITHOUT LAWFUL</u>"; in line 26, after "OF" insert "<u>PUPIL</u>"; and in the same line, strike "SHALL"; in line 27, after "(1)" insert "<u>SHALL</u>"; in line 28, strike "INCLUDING" and substitute "<u>AND MAY PROVIDE</u>"; in the same line, strike "OTHER"; and in line 29, strike "OR" and substitute "AND".

On page 2, in line 1, strike "FILE A COMPLAINT WITH" and substitute "<u>FOLLOWING THE INVESTIGATION OR INTERVENTION</u>, <u>MAY NOTIFY</u>"; in line 2, strike "ALLEGING"; and in the same line, strike "IS A CHILD IN NEED OF SUPERVISION" and substitute "<u>HAS BEEN HABITUALLY TRUANT</u>, <u>WITHOUT LAWFUL EXCUSE</u>".

## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 2, insert:

"(C) THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT, THE SUPERVISOR OF PUPIL PERSONNEL,

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OR THE SUPERINTENDENT'S DESIGNEE SHALL PROVIDE TO THE LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY FOR INCLUSION IN THE REPORT OF THE LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY UNDER § 7-303(E) OF THIS SUBTITLE INFORMATION REGARDING THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS IDENTIFIED AS BEING HABITUALLY TRUANT.

<u>7-303.</u>

(e) At the end of each fiscal year, each participating local education agency shall submit a written statement to the State Department of Education [describing] THAT DESCRIBES:

(1) [the] THE assessment, the educational problems determined, the overall program developed with goals and procedures, and a yearly evaluation of the success of the program AS PROVIDED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION; AND

(2) INFORMATION REGARDING THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS IDENTIFIED AS BEING HABITUALLY TRUANT AS PROVIDED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF § 7-302(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE.".
