On page 11, in lines 1 and 2, strike "BY THE STATE"; in line 3, after "BY" insert "<u>THE</u> <u>STATE</u>,"; in line 4, after "STATE" insert "<u>, OR AN ENTITY THAT PROVIDES ALCOHOL AND</u> <u>DRUG COUNSELING SERVICES UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OR A POLITICAL</u> <u>SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE</u>"; in the same line, strike the period and substitute "<u>; AND</u>"; after line 4, insert:

"(III) THE PERSON HAS COMPLETED NOT LESS THAN 3 YEARS WITH A MINIMUM OF 3,000 HOURS OF SUPERVISED EXPERIENCE IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE COUNSELING APPROVED BY THE BOARD, 2 YEARS OF WHICH SHALL HAVE BEEN COMPLETED AFTER THE AWARD OF THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE.";

strike in their entirety lines 5 through 18, inclusive; in line 23, after the comma insert "<u>OR</u>"; strike beginning with the comma in line 24 down through "THERAPIST"" in line 25; in line 26, after the third comma, insert "<u>OR</u>"; in line 27, strike ", OR "C.A.C.-D.A.T.""; in line 30, after the comma insert "<u>OR</u>"; and strike beginning with the comma in line 31 down through "THERAPIST" in line 32.

On page 12, in line 4, after the third comma, insert "<u>OR</u>"; in line 5, strike ", OR "C.A.C.-D.A.T.""; in line 9, strike the comma and substitute "<u>OR</u>"; and strike beginning with the comma in line 10 down through "THERAPIST"" in line 11.
