AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 215

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 3, after “changes;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act, subject to a certain contingency;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 32, in line 25, after “1996.” insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of September 30, 1999, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect, except that if the Maryland State Police submit to the General Assembly, on or before September 1, 1999, a report that contains clear and convincing evidence from the Maryland State Police or another bona fide criminal statistics reporting organization that incidences of gun-related crime have decreased in the State at least 1% from the level of such incidences on October 1, 1996, this Act shall remain in effect unless abrogated by an Act of the General Assembly.”.
