AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 236

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Alcoholic Beverages Violations” and substitute “Drinking or Possessing Intoxicating Beverages on School Premises”; in line 6, after “committed” insert “a”; in the same line, strike “violations” and substitute “violation”; in line 8, after “committed” insert “a”; and in line 9, strike “violations” and substitute “violation”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 19, strike “SUBPARAGRAPH (iii)” and substitute “SUBPARAGRAPHS (III) AND (IV)”; in line 21, strike the brackets; in the same line, strike “SHALL”; in line 29, strike the brackets; and in line 30, strike “SHALL”.

On page 2, after line 5, insert:

“(IV) IN MAKING A DISPOSITION ON A FINDING THAT THE CHILD HAS COMMITTED A VIOLATION UNDER § 26-103 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, THE COURT SHALL ORDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION TO INITIATE AN ACTION, UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS, TO SUSPEND THE DRIVING PRIVILEGE OF A CHILD LICENSED TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN 30 DAYS NOR MORE THAN 90 DAYS.”;

and in line 6, strike “(iv)” and substitute “(V)”.
